A Note From Bishop Vasa concerning the Coro19 Virus

- I assure the faithful that if they are sick or are experiencing symptoms of sickness, they are not obliged to attend Mass, and even that out of charity they ought not to attend.
- The practice of people holding hands during the Our Father with non-family members is to be discouraged;
- the exchange of the sign of peace is to be suspended (or that it be exchanged without physical contact);
- In the Diocese of Santa Rosa: The distribution of Holy Communion from the Chalice is to be suspended until the danger of the present virus is eliminated.

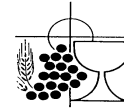
ICF FISH FRY
