

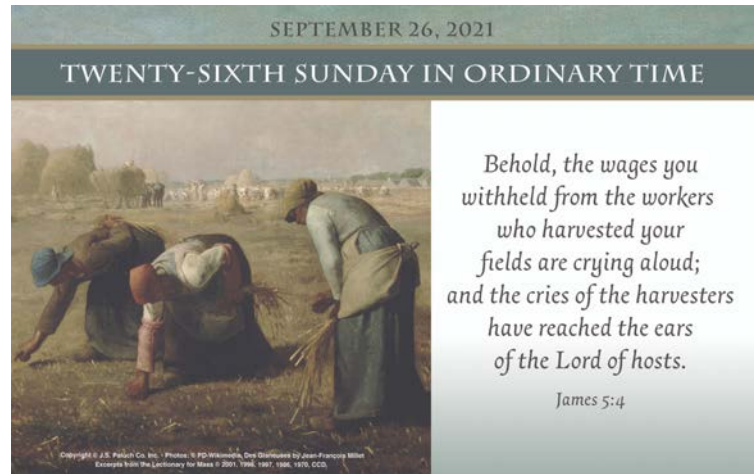

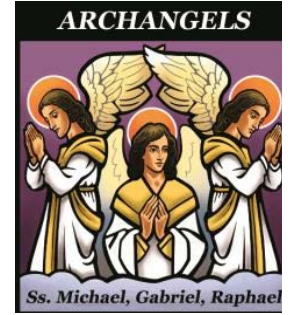
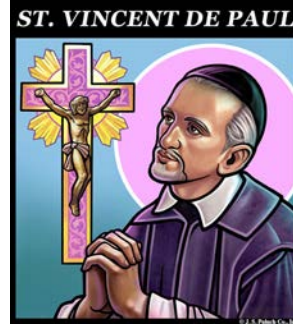
Bible Study
